Who we are

What information do we collect?

Information you give us

- Personal details such as name, address and contact details, for internal use and contact purposes.
- Work history for references / suitability for screening purposes.
- Compensation to manage expectations.
- Education and skills for screening purposes.
- Other information provided in your application or on your CV.

Information we get from your use of our website

- **Cookies**

We use various technologies including cookies to enhance your online experience. We use these technologies to collect and store information when you visit our website and this may include information to identify your browser or device and to analyse web traffic. More information on our use of cookies is provided in our Cookie Policy.

Information we get from other sources

- Publicly available information/social media, for example Linked In.

How we use your information

General

The information we collect is used by us for the purposes of assessing your suitability for the advertised role.

Security

The personal information you provide is held securely and in confidence by us in our computer systems and filing systems and other records. When we process your personal information we do so in compliance with the law. We maintain strict security standards and procedures to prevent unauthorised access to your data.

Legal basis

We are allowed to use and share your information in the ways described in this Privacy Notice:

- Where it is necessary to do so in order to take steps to consider you for and to enter into a contract of employment.
- Where our use of your information is necessary for our legitimate business interests, such as research and statistical purposes.

With whom do we share your information?

We may share your information with Group companies.

How long will we store your information?

If unsuccessful, we will retain your Curriculum Vitae for 6 months at which point your details will be deleted. If you are successful and are offered employment, we will retain it on your employment file – please refer to our iGO4 Staff Employment Privacy Notice for more information.

Your information rights

You have the right to access information held about you, on written request, and if necessary to rectify any errors or omissions in that information. Please write to the Data Protection Officer at dataprotection@igo4.com or at iGO4 Ltd, iGO4 House, Staniland Way, Peterborough, PE4 6JT. If we receive repeated requests from you, we reserve the right to charge a fee for this.

You have the following additional rights in respect of your personal information:

- **Erasure:** in certain circumstances you will have the right to ask us to erase information we hold about you. We are not required to erase information if we still need it for the purposes for which it was collected or processed or where we have other legal grounds for processing your information.
- **Restrict processing:** where you do not wish your information to be erased, you may instead have the right to ask us to restrict our processing of your information. This right is only available in limited circumstances, such as where you believe the information we hold about you is inaccurate or is being processed improperly. The right would apply during the period that we are checking its accuracy or legality.
- **Portability:** to receive a copy of the personal data you have provided to us, in a commonly used machine-readable format, and to transfer that personal data to another data controller. Where it is technically feasible you may also have the right to request us to transfer the data directly to another data controller.
- **Object:** where we are processing your information on the grounds of it being in our legitimate interests to do so, you have the right to object to that processing.
- **Automated decision making and profiling:** where we use automated processing to make a decision which may produce a legal or similarly significant effect on you, you may request human intervention, express your point of view and contest the decision.

Your right to complain

You have the right to raise a privacy complaint with the Information Commissioner's Office (ICO). The ICO will usually require you to have approached us first to try to resolve the matter.
